Crime/Incident Breakdown

Hinderwell Parish:

No incidents of note

Mickleby, Ugthorpe and Roxby Parishes:

9th September A resident of Ugthorpe reported criminal damage to their car caused by a known female resident hitting the rear tail light of the car with a stick and breaking it – Ongoing enquiries.

24th September – Approx 2110Hrs Report from a Resident of a farm in the Barnby area of an attempted arson – Officers attended, NOT arson but a youngster had an accident while working on a motorbike.

Hawsker and Sneaton Parishes:

16th September Report from an employee of Bothams bakery, Enterprise Way of an E-Bike stolen from outside the premises locked up. Discovered at approx 1925Hrs there was no sign of the bike or lock. In addition the complainant reports that they had another E-bike stolen 2 weeks prior to this from a shed at their home address in the streonshalh ward area – Enquiries ongoing.

26th September – Report from a resident of Low Hawsker that their Land rover had been interfered with overnight, discovered in the morning unlocked and all the windows down – No damage or items stolen.

30th September Approx 1220Hrs – Report from a resident of Stainsacre that another male resident has been issuing threats to kill and has assaulted – Officers attended the offending suspect had left the area and enquiries continue.

15th September Approx 0818hrs Report of a dog bite to a child Manor Road/Thorpe Lane, RHB – A black terrier type dog belonging to a resident of Thorpe Lane bit a child on the ankle while walking across the road – Enquiries ongoing.

16th September Approx 2310Hrs Report from a male in drink outside The Fylingdales Inn of assault. – Officers attended and a male arrested for common assault.

1st September Approx 2130Hrs A male resident of Selstone Crescent was assaulted by another male on the victim's premises – Common assault offences were committed but the complainant declined to prosecute.

16th September Approx 1812Hrs – Serious Road traffic collision on A169 Blue bank. – Single vehicle (Motorcycle) involved causing a fatality to the rider NOK informed and enquiries ongoing – (incl in RTC stat below).

Glaisdale Parish:

3rd September – Report from a resident of Lealholm of males with dogs poaching on the road between Lealholm and Houlsyke – Officers attended and located two male offenders in possession of evidence effecting arrest and seizure dogs.

5th September Approx 2105Hrs – Report from Underhill, Glaisdale of a suspicious Black 1 series Mercedes Partial Reg **ME1*C*C** driving in on private property for unknown purposes? – Officers attended the area and report from ANPR that the vehicle had been sited leaving the Whitby/North Yorks area. – No offences

22nd September Report of overnight shed burglary at High walls Farm, Oakley Walls – Quad bike and some tools stolen – Op ALIBI Enquiries ongoing.

25th September – Report of a suspicious White Ford Transit Reg – **BG*7VZY** acting suspiciously in Glaisdale – Seen entering the farm yard at Glaisdale Hall Farm and later in Castleton. Police have conducted enquiries and it may be false plates but more likely to have been read incorrectly due to the screw caps in the number plates making the letters appear different. However, if seen again we would ask residents to report it immediately. Thank you.
