Crime/Incident Breakdown

Hinderwell Parish:

5th February Approx 1450Hrs – Report from a resident High Street, Hinderwell that a male has attended the address alleging he was from the energy company and needed to read the meter – The reportee refused to let the suspicious male into property and on leaving he has kicked over a potted plant – Criminal damage. It has not yet been confirmed or denied by the energy company if this was a genuine agent? It is still possible that this was an attempted sneak-in burglary and local residents should be aware to make full credential checks of any persons attending their homes.

10th February Delayed report from a resident of the Staithes area that another resident of the Staithes area assaulted the reportee on 1st Feb while in a retail premises on the High Street, Staithes. – Reportee did not want the incident investigated – crime recorded.

15th February Delayed report from a resident of the Staithes area that another resident of the Staithes area had assaulted the Reportee earlier on the same day as this report. Occurred in a licensed premises – Enquiries ongoing.

25th February Approx 0200Hrs Quad bike seen driving through Hinderwell High Street at speed following a silver vehicle, male with dark hoody and no helmet – Op ALIBI, stolen from Cliff Farm, Kettleness (reported when discovered at 0425Hrs). Police officers did pick up the vehicles in Cleveland and a brief chase occurred but abandoned due to public safety issues.

Mickleby, Ugthorpe and Roxby Parishes:

28th February Approx 2205Hrs Report of a suspicious Silver Bentley Continental Reg C*540F* driving up to Birch Hill Farm, Roxby. Reportee got into their vehicle and drove to intercept the vehicle which sped off when they saw the reportee's vehicle – cross referred report earlier in the evening from Mulgrave area of a suspicious male linked to the vehicle smelling of cannabis and alcohol.

Hawsker and Sneaton Parishes:

24th February Between approx. 1130Hrs and 1515Hrs Officers were involved in a domestic violence incident occurring a father and (adult) son at a property in Stainsacre – It appears the family were from South Yorkshire and the incident spilled out into public areas in the Stainsacre area. A male was arrested and taken to Scarborough custody.

Fylingdales Parishes:

3rd February Approx 1600Hrs – Report from a r of Fylingthorpe of a dog on dog attack by the bus stop, Thorpe Lane, RHB. Reportee also had an injury to a finger – The owner of the attacking dog identified themselves after an appeal and the incident has been investigated – The injury to the RP was inconclusive on how it occurred and the RP's dog was not injured during the attack – NFA

Newholm, Aislaby and Lythe Parishes:

25th February Approx 0425Hrs Report from a local farmer of kettleness that a quad bike stolen from Cliff Farm had occurred at 0130Hrs (see quad seen report in Hinderwell at 0200Hrs) – Op ALIBI. Vehicle was fitted with a tracker and was tracked to the Grangetown area. Officers attended and discovered the tracker had been ripped out of the vehicle. A number of power tools were also located with the discarded tracker but unknown where they are from – Enquiries ongoing

Sleights Parish

21st February Approx 2245Hrs Report from Ambulance service that a 20yrs Male Whitby resident riding a E-Scooter had collided with a bollard at the bridge on the A169 at Sleights, suspected leg fracture? – Road traffic offences in consideration and enquiries ongoing.

25th February – Report from a resident of Sleights that they have located some suspicious wires and signage to fields off The Cliff, Iburndale. The fields are home to horses and the reportee is concerned that the signage and suspicious equipment is preparatory evidence of conspiracy to steal/damage etc – Local SNT investigating the situation.

****Information Incident**** On 25th February a teenage male resident to the Whitby area was contacted through a social media site from unknown persons attempting to extort money from the teenager with an AI generated naked body with the victims head/face. The family of the victim and the victim himself took all the correct actions – contacted Police asap and did not respond to the extorter(s) threats to publish the images. To our knowledge none of the images have been published anywhere for public viewing and enquiries are still ongoing. – We urge all users of social media to be aware of this sort of extortion/blackmail and contact Police immediately any threats are made.
